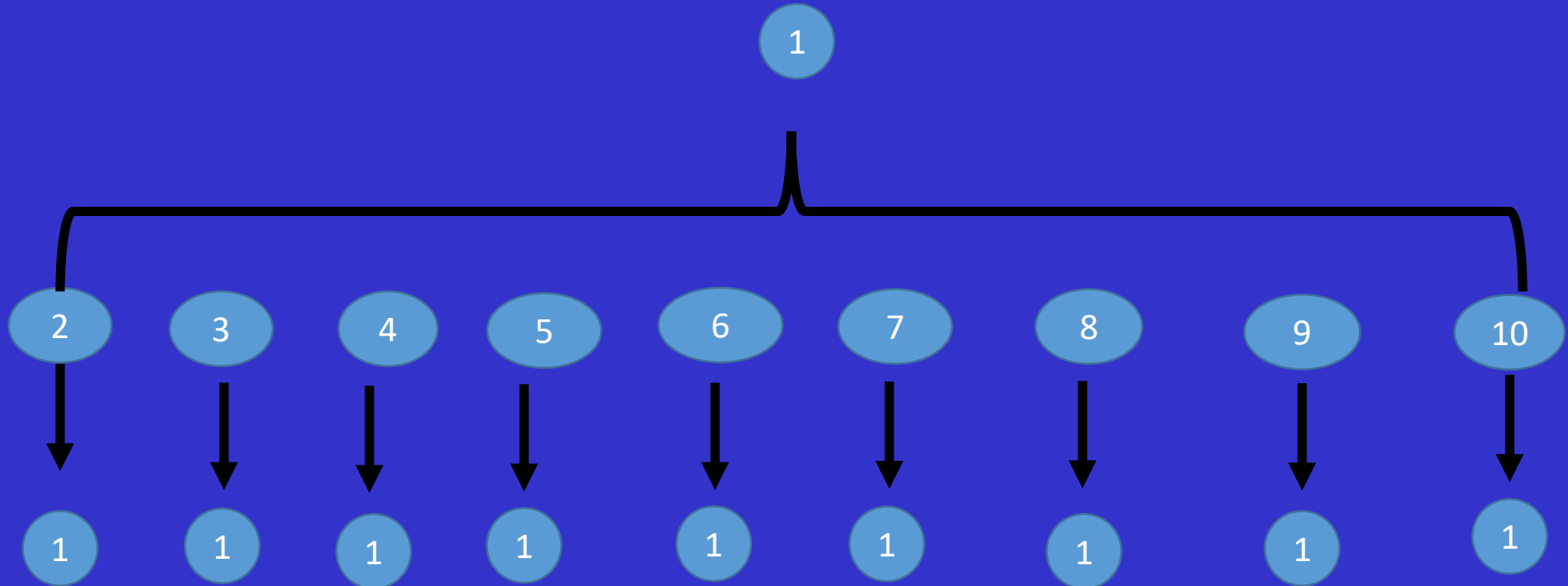

The Power of 10 - Squad



Sept 1st to Sept 4th

- Form a committee of two, three or four, etc.
- Post flyer to Church's Website/Personal Website
- Sign on to Telegram Communication Platform (Instructions forth coming)

Sept 7th to Sept 12th

- The captain's committee shall start calls to Senior Citizens and 18-26 year olds to verify they are registered and ask for their voting preference.
- If voting preference is by absentee ballot, start the process for requesting/obtaining the application to request the ballot. Be sure to view deadlines.
- If not registered, review with them the registration options and deadlines in the Operation Vote Now Guide.
- Assist with getting registrations completed and submitted
- Select date for viewing of Operation Vote Now presentation
 - Church Conference or Class Leader Style
- Re-post flyers on church's social media and/or personal media

Sept 14th to Sept 19th

- View Operation Vote Now presentation (A general agenda with talking points is forth coming)
- Follow up on calls made during week of Sept 7th
- Assist with completing registration forms or absentee ballot applications.
- Conduct outreach efforts – Voter Registration Drive
 - Partner with Barber Shops, Hair Salons, Nail Salons and ask to leave registration forms at their shops for customers to fill out. Set date to return to pick up and deliver to Board of Elections.
